The ICAA Peter C. Marzio Award for Outstanding Research in 20th-Century Latin American and Latino Art

Eligibility and Requirements

Eligibility

Any student enrolled in a graduate and/or undergraduate program in the U.S. or abroad is eligible to submit a paper for consideration for the Peter C. Marzio Award. The paper must be substantially based on the primary and critical materials available through the Documents Project digital archive, accessed through www.icaadocs.mfah.org, and the companion book series distributed by Yale University Press. Papers may be submitted in English, Spanish, or Portuguese. The papers will be reviewed by an award committee composed of members of the Editorial Board of the Documents Project. The two selected papers—one graduate and one undergraduate-level paper—will be published on the ICAA Documents Project website.

Submission Requirements

The deadline for 2018 submissions is July 30.

The application form and an electronic copy of the essay should be submitted for consideration to Beatriz Olivetti, ICAA Documents Project Research and Digital Experience Specialist, at bolivetti@mfah.org. Or, by regular mail, submit a hard copy postmarked no later than July 30, 2018, to: PO Box 6826, Houston, Texas 77265-6826.

Undergraduate students should submit a paper between 15 and 20 pages in length, excluding cover page, bibliography and appendices. Graduate students should submit a paper between 20 and 25 pages in length, excluding cover page, bibliography and appendices.

Formatting and Image Requirements

- Prospective candidates should follow the *Chicago Manual of Style* for all formatting, including footnotes and bibliography.
- Papers should be double-spaced; Times New Roman Font, point size 12; should allow for one-inch margins; and should contain footnotes, not endnotes.
- Submissions should include at least 5 and no more than 15 images.
- All images should be in JPG format and must include captions.
- In addition, the ICAA Record ID must be provided for all documents accessed through the Documents Project's digital archive.
